Key Messages

The following statements are the key messages we'd like to convey with Child Safeguarding Week. Please use these in any of your posts or in a way that works best for you.

- Sexual abuse is preventable!
- Every week should be Child Safeguarding Week!
- Every day of every week, our children need to be protected from abuse and neglect.
- Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility.
- Every person was born with mana, everyone is sacred, no-one was born to be abused.
- Get help for people with sexual thoughts or behaviours towards children, they CAN change!
